pronounce the following final order
and decree.

It is ordered, adjudged and
decreed by the Court that bonds of
matrimony heretofore existing between
the said Complainant and said
defendant be forever dissolved, annulled
and vacated, and made void. And it
is further ordered and decreed by
the Court that said Complainant
retain the care and custody of her
child and that said defendant be
precluded, and enjoined and restrained
from exercising any acts of authority
or control over said child. And it is

that said Complainant do recover
against defendant her costs and charges
